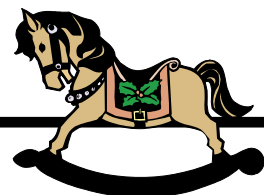


Ways to Remember a Brother or Sister Who Died

- ❖ Make a memory book
- ❖ Draw pictures
- ❖ Write a poem or a story
- ❖ Suggest to the parent(s) that they ask if any of their children want something that belonged to their brother or sister to keep for themselves
- ❖ Make a photo album that has pictures of their baby in it
- ❖ Make up a song
- ❖ Go to the cemetery and visit the baby
- ❖ Have the family add the baby's name to birthday cards, Mother's Day cards, Father's Day cards, or any other holiday card when it is signed
- ❖ Talk to the family about keeping a picture of the baby in each of their children's rooms
- ❖ Tell a special friend about the baby
- ❖ Help raise money for SIDS
- ❖ Use a tape recorder and share things about their baby brother or sister
- ❖ Ask other people to talk into the tape recorder to share what they remember
- ❖ Plant a tree
- ❖ Write a letter addressed to the brother or sister who died
- ❖ As appropriate, suggest they pray for the baby
- ❖ Do something special on the day their brother or sister was born
- ❖ Do something special on the day their brother or sister died
- ❖ Write a letter about their baby brother or sister who died and share it with other family members
- ❖ Give a gift to a hospital for children in honor of their brother or sister
